Please enter the main entrance of Rugby School Thailand (*also signposted Wisdom Valley*) and drive through the first security guard on your right, they will direct you to the second security gate further up the road. At this gate, you will see our Wisdom Camp flags leading you to the Administration building car park. Park your car at the Admin building carpark where you will see many members of the Camp Crew ready to receive you.

Camper Registration

The Camp Crew will receive and register Campers allocating their Camp Tribe and showing them to their Boarding House. We will issue you zip-loc bags for any medication your child is taking and our Camp Nurses will take all the medications and instructions from you and prepare their registers.

Welcome and School Tour

At 9:50 am I would like to welcome you to a brief presentation from myself and the Rugby School Thailand CEO, Khun Eve Teepsuwan. This will take place in the Veraphan Theatre. Our Camp Crew will help to direct you there. If you requested a school tour on your registration form, you will be personally contacted by our admissions department very soon. The school tour will begin at 10:30 am right after the presentations.

The Summer Camp Program will have already started and the Campers will be busy meeting their Tribe and Camp Crew. You are welcome to leave straight after the School Tour or continue any conversations with our Admissions Team.

Phone Home Wednesday

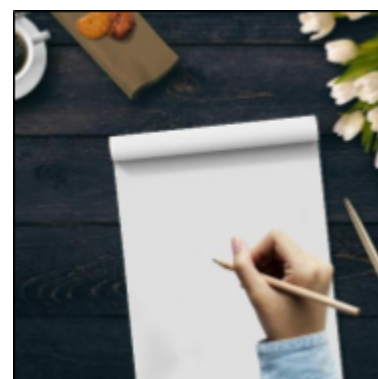


Please keep your mobiles close on Wednesday. Your child will have their mobile phone / tablet returned to them and they will call you between 8:00 pm - 8:30 pm.

Some children may become tearful when they speak to you, your voice will heighten their anxiety and they may become upset. This is very normal, it does not mean they are unhappy. Please praise and encourage your child as much as possible. They are becoming more independent and stronger children!

Please expect a letter in return. Kids love writing letters when on camp and we encourage it, especially when they are feeling a little homesick.

Please remember you cannot share any photos on Social Media if there are other children in the photo unless you seek their parent's permission first.

Medication

Camper safety is paramount here at Wisdom Camp and Rugby School Thailand. Therefore we ask any child who is taking any kind of medication to hand this in to the Nurse team at registration and complete a Consent form. We urge you to prepare their medication in a clearly labelled separate bag with all the instructions and doses and medicine taking times clearly labelled.

We need to know exactly the length, dosage and reason for taking the medication. No child should have any medication of any kind in their bag at the boarding house during their stay. Our Nurses will administer the medication at the required times.

We can provide you with Zip Lock bags and Labels on arrival day if you need to re-pack any medication.

Room Allocation

We have 2 separate boarding houses on campus and our rooms range from 6-bed rooms to 1-bed ensuite rooms.

The Head Nurse and Camp Director have spent a long time discussing and choosing campers' room allocation. We have taken into consideration your rooming requests as we

want to get this right the first time to keep the boarding house and camper satisfaction to a maximum. Please note that we cannot guarantee all rooming requests and cannot make changes on arrival day.

Our campers will be advised that wherever they are placed, they can share the common rooms situated on each floor of the boarding house right up until their bedtime, so everyone has plenty of time to hang out with one another.



Mobiles and Devices

Mobile phones or tablets will be kept securely with the boarding matron. Only on the dedicated phone home days will your child be allowed to use their phones or tablets to call you. There is no reason to think your child needs extra food, snacks or sweets throughout their stay, they don't. Food in the dormitories is forbidden. We provide an extensive buffet at meal times as well as snacks in the morning, afternoon and evenings. Your child will never go hungry with the amount we provide for them.

Lost Property

We strongly recommend you label all your child's belongings. Our staff are always conscious of how frequently children can misplace and lose their items; we always try our best to avoid lost property. If you do leave anything behind, please contact the Camp Crew for assistance.

Laundry

Our boarding houses are fully equipped with laundry facilities and we have a program to ensure all our Camper clothing is laundered and clean during their stay.

Please do not bring

Nuts, food, snacks, computer games, jewellery, money.

Accidents & Injuries

We have 4 full-time qualified Nurses on camp during the day and night. Our fantastic nurses will be there to administer any medication your child requires. We have 3 medical centres around our school campus, with isolation rooms. We also have vehicles on standby for any emergencies.

If a child requires further medical treatment our Nurse will take them to BHP (Bangkok Hospital Pattaya). Our school and camps have a great relationship with the hospital and we will all work together to solve any issues quickly and professionally.

The parents will of course be contacted for any medical issues your child may have on camp.

Insurance

The Camp purchases insurance for all campers in case of accidents.

International Campers

International Campers are urged to have travel insurance covering lost baggage, delayed flights, accidents, sickness, illness and repatriation. Please ensure this is purchased in your home country before travelling to Thailand.

Residential Camper Packing Guide

Please pack as closely as you can to our guide and add anything personal your child may need.

If your child would like to bring a musical instrument to camp, they are welcome to. We encourage the campers to play their instruments around the campfire and practice in the boarding house music room whenever possible.

Packing Guide

Day Campers should arrive ready for their Camp Activities. See the Camp schedule for the activities in particular the water sports and excursion.

On arrival day we will provide the following:

Tribe T-Shirts x 3

Water Bottle x 1

Campers should arrive each day dressed in their Tribe shirts, hats and wearing sports shoes.

Day Campers do not require much in addition to the suggested items below. Please pack as closely as you can to our guide.

Device Free Camp

At Wisdom Camp, we embrace a device-free environment to encourage campers to fully engage in activities, build social connections, and immerse themselves in the camp experience. For this reason, we kindly ask that AirTags, GPS trackers, and smartwatches are not brought to camp. These devices can become distractions and detract from the spirit of the camp.

Rest assured, our Camp Crew prioritises the safety and well-being of all campers, with comprehensive measures in place to ensure a secure and enriching experience. Thank you for supporting our commitment to a focused, tech-free environment.

Please note we are also a **NUT FREE SCHOOL** please do not bring your own snacks to camp.

Camp Tribes

We feel that healthy competition is crucial in today's modern world. Therefore, each Camper and Camp Crew member will be allocated a Tribe. At this year's Summer Camp there will be six tribes: Pandas, Penguins, Piranhas, Peregrines, Pythons and Panthers. Each tribe is determined by the camper ages and will be lead by an experienced Tribe Leader and 2- 3 Camp Crew.

The children are expected to wear their Tribe T-shirts during all activities. We will split the children into their Tribes for all their activities and award them Tribe points as appropriate for achievement in the activities and during camp generally, for positive behaviour, teamwork, effort and kindness.

All points are recorded on a live file and we will update the Tribes at every mealtime on the current leaderboard standings. At the end of the camp, we will announce the overall winner of Summer Camp 2026!



Departure Day - Saturday 5th and 11th July 2026

Sadly, all good things must come to an end, but before we say goodbye we are inviting you to join us from 9:45 am to watch the final Tribe challenges and the Farewell presentation at 11:00 am. At 11:45 we will have some refreshments available for you before you set off home.

Campers joining us for both weeks of Camp will depart for the Yacht excursion at 12:00.

When you arrive at Rugby School Thailand we will have signs and ask security to direct you to the school's indoor sports centre, the 'Webb Ellis Center' (WEC). Please park at the car park and walk into the main entrance of the WEC. It will all be signposted. All the children and their luggage will be at the indoor basketball courts.

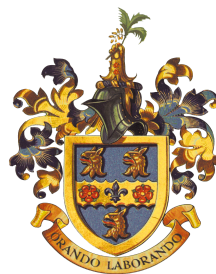
