Please enter the main entrance of Rugby School Thailand (*also signposted Wisdom Valley*) and drive through the first security guard on your right, they will direct you to the second security gate further up the road. At this gate, you will see our Wisdom Camp flags leading you to the Administration building car park. Park your car at the Admin building carpark where you will see many members of the Camp Crew ready to welcome you.

Camper Registration - from 8:45 am

The Camp Crew will receive and register Campers, distributing their Camp shirts and showing them to their Boarding House. We will issue you zip-loc bags for any medication your child is taking, and our Camp Nurses will take all the medications and instructions from you and prepare their registers.

Welcome and School Tour

At 9:50 am, I would like to welcome you to a brief presentation from the Camp Directors and the Rugby School Thailand CEO, Khun Eve Teepsuwan. This will take place in the Veraphan Theatre. Our Camp Crew will help to direct you there. If you requested a school tour on your registration form, you will be personally contacted by our admissions department very soon. The school tour will begin at 10:30 am, right after the presentations.

The Camp Program will have already started and the Campers will be busy meeting their new friends, teachers and Camp Crew. You are welcome to leave straight after the School Tour or continue any conversations with our Admissions Team.

Phone Home Day



Please keep your mobiles close on **Saturday, 8th and Tuesday, 11th August**. Your child will have their mobile phone/tablet returned to them, and they will call you between **7:45 pm - 8:45 pm**.

Some children may become tearful when they speak to you; your voice will heighten their anxiety, and they may become upset. This is very normal; it does not mean they are unhappy. Please praise and encourage your child as much as possible. They are becoming more independent and stronger children!

If you would like to send a message of support and love to your child during camp, please write them a letter and email a scanned copy or a picture of it to campletters@rugbyschool.ac.th. We will print and deliver these messages to your child the very next day.

Please expect a letter in return. Children love writing letters when at camp, and we encourage it, especially when they are feeling a little homesick.

Medication

Camper safety is paramount here at Wisdom Camp and Rugby School Thailand. Therefore, we ask any child who is taking any kind of medication to hand this in to the Nurse team at registration. We urge you to prepare their medication in a clearly labelled separate bag with all the instructions, doses and medicine taking times clearly labelled.

We need to know exactly the length, dosage and reason for taking the medication. No child should have any medication of any kind in their bag at the boarding house during their stay. Our Nurses will administer the medication at the required times.

We can provide you with Zip Lock bags and Labels on arrival day if you need to re-pack any medication.

Room Allocation

Our boarding house has rooms with 4-6 beds in each room, and we are ensuring a mixed blend of nationalities in the rooms to encourage cultural mixing, new friendships and importantly the use of English as the main language of communication.

Boys and girls are on different floors within the boarding house with a dedicated Boarding Crew adult supporting them.

All the campers can share the common room areas situated on each floor of the boarding house right up until their bedtime, so everyone has plenty of time to socialise with one another.



Mobiles and Devices

Mobile phones or tablets will be kept securely with the boarding matron. Only on the dedicated phone home days will your child be allowed to use their phones or tablets to call you. This device-free environment allows the campers to fully immerse themselves in the camp activities and their new friends.

Meals

We provide an extensive buffet at all main meal times with plenty of healthy options. We have taken into consideration your child's dietary requirements, and our catering team will prepare suitable meals for them. We also provide healthy snacks in the morning, afternoon and evenings, including fresh fruit and milk.

Lost Property

We strongly recommend that you label all your child's belongings. Our staff are always conscious of how frequently children can misplace and lose their items; we always try our best to avoid lost property. If you do leave anything behind, please contact the Camp Crew for assistance.

Laundry

Our boarding houses are fully equipped with laundry facilities, and we have a program to ensure all our campers' clothing is laundered each day, ensuring they have fresh and clean clothing during their stay.

Please do not bring

Nuts, food, snacks, computer games, jewellery, money.

Please note that snacks, candy or any medication or supplements in the dormitories are forbidden

Accidents & Injuries

We have 3 full-time qualified Nurses on camp during the day and night. Our fantastic nurses will be there to administer any medication your child requires. We have 3 medical centres around our school campus, with isolation rooms. We also have vehicles on standby for any emergencies.

If a child requires further medical treatment, our Nurse will take them to BHP (Bangkok Hospital Pattaya). Our school and camps have a great relationship with the hospital, and we will all work together to solve any issues quickly and professionally.

The parents will, of course, be contacted for any medical issues your child may have while at camp.

Camp Insurance

The camp provides personal accident insurance for all children joining the Camp. This is included in your Camp Fee. The insurance limit for Campers is 10,000 THB.

International Campers

As most of our Campers are travelling internationally to us, we recommend having valid travel insurance covering lost baggage, delayed flights, accidents, sickness, illness, and repatriation. Please ensure this is purchased in your home country before travelling to Thailand.

If your child would like to bring a musical instrument to camp, they are welcome. We encourage the campers to play their instruments around the campfire and practice in the boarding house music room whenever possible.
